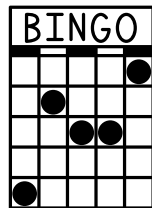
MAKING BETTER LIVES – WELLNESS SERIES

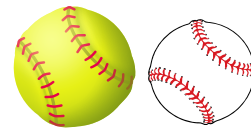
